In preparation for your student's return, we'd like to share some information to hopefully address some of your questions and concerns. Please read through the following information.

Student Arrival {August 25th, 2025}

6th Grade ONLY: Arrive at 9:00 AM for special 1st day admission. This delayed arrival is for the **1st day ONLY**

- Entrance located on Verree Road 6th grade lower patio.
- Students will meet their advisor. All teachers will have section number signs

7th Grade: Arrive at the regular time of 8:15 AM

- Enter through the 6th grade entrance
- Report to your advisory class from last year to receive your chromebooks.
- Students will transition to their new advisory at 8:45AM

8th Grade: Arrive at the regular time of 8:15 AM.

- Enter through the 7th grade entrance.
- Report to your advisory class from last year to receive your chromebooks.
- Students will transition to their new advisory at 8:45 AM

Additional FAQs

- Parent Drop Off/Pick Up - Students are to be dropped off on Verree Road. **No cars are permitted to enter or park in the school lot.** The lot is reserved for staff parking, yellow bus/SEPTA drop off and Parent with color coded drop off passes.
- When picking up students follow these parameters.
 - There is NO PARKING in the school zone/Bus lanes.
 - There is **NO DOUBLE PARKING** and **NO U TURNS** (Tickets will be issued) .
 - Communicate with students where you will be to pick them up.
 - For safety, students must cross the street **at the light, not in the middle of traffic.**
- Students must know their [SEPTA bus number and schedule](#) for dismissal. Remember that SEPTA has discontinued the following bus routes, 88, 476, 478 and the 490(in January)
- Students are expected to be in full uniform beginning on the 1st day of school. Entry begins at 8:12 AM each school day, and school starts promptly at 8:25 AM each morning.
- Breakfast - Served daily from 7:45 AM to 8:15 AM beginning on Tuesday, August 26, 2025
- **The morning fitness program will not begin** until September. The date will be announced on Dojo.
- **Student IDs** - School IDs will be printed and distributed to students. School IDs are expected to be worn on a lanyard when students are on campus. Lanyards will be provided to students.
- **School Supplies** - The general supply list is on our school website <https://baldi.philasd.org> Teachers may provide a list of specific items needed for their classroom during the first week of school.
- **Lunch** - Students will be provided lunches in the cafeteria. Due to the large population of students, 6 lunch periods will occur per day. All students must swipe their ID's for lunch in the cafeteria.
- **Transpasses** - All Philadelphia students will be allowed to ride SEPTA for free in the morning on Monday, August 25, 2025. All eligible students as determined by the School District of Philadelphia will receive their transpass on the first day of school.
